3. Fundraising activities including PWR 100 Club and charity running tops

Martyn Panting (MP) attended the meeting for the first 30 minutes to discuss fundraising activities for the new club charity The Chris Aked Foundation.

MP presented the idea of the PWR100Club and provided the committee with the research he had done into the options including confirming research into Gambling commission rules and differences between:

Private society lottery – no specific licence or admin (most done this way) Small society lottery – no licence but does need registering with local authority

Private Society lottery – seems to be the easiest as no cost in registration but it does needs physical tickets and cannot be carried out virtually/online

The draw has to happen in a physical location – suggestion is last Tuesday of month Willet Rec Can't be advertised over social media/email/text – leaflets could be handed out on a Tuesday night and emailed to members after but original advertisement cannot be done over social media.

MP agreed to amend the wording to ensure full year payment to be made and not every month to minimise admin for the Treasurer.

JW requested that we amend the renewal cost for Second claim members to be £12.50 per month to avoid confusion over payments. All agreed.

Committee agreed it would be easier if we applied for a small society lottery licence due to the restrictions in advertising and MP agreed to look into this.

Licence option to be tied to membership renewal and AR to add details to the registration form.

Licence owner requires a name - PWR Secretary to be assigned

PWR Chris Aked Charity shirt to be offered to members but not to be worn on race days as it is not an affiliated top.

Other ideas suggested include:

Heads and Tails and raffle to be organised for PWR Quiz

MP to speak to LS if there are any ideas he has such as competition against Orpington, race nights etc

Marathon ballet winners to be contacted to encourage them to join the charity and MP would set up a Just Giving page

RD at this point confirmed the following had been arranged.

4. Social secretary Update (LS)

The committee discussed the difficulty in selling tickets

AR and NM to assist LS on the night

Theatre trip – Rock of ages 8/2/23 being advertised and organised by Sally O'Callaghan The Leaders Social Night 15/2/23 - arranged for The Bull. Concerns over timing with half term but LS confirmed 37 has agreed. Some discrepancy over costs but LS hoping to clear up with venue. Midsummer Run – To be 20^{th} July but venue not confirmed

5. AGM

NM confirmed the AGM is fast approaching and asked if anyone was not standing again to let it be known. JD & NM stepping down, TS to confirm DS will remain for another year

6. DBS verification

Confirmed requires 3 different proof of ID from now
