28 seats sold for Bushy Park and needs to be readvertised or offered to Orpies

Questionnaire - 92 responders gave positive feedback.

Date clash was main reason for not attending Winter Party

Events like to see - More train runs, 5k Handicap run followed by pub popular, Comedy Club in Chislehurst, Athletic or Sports event, Dodgeball was popular, Orienteering running events such as at Shoreham end up at Vineyard or Keston ending up at a pub. LS to investigate suggestions.

Consideration of additional roles to be created by future committee such as a Volunteer Coordinator.

### 8. Ballot Criteria (NM)

Difficult to measure in previous years.

Committee members, Track coach and race director to be automatically in the ballot.

Regular leaders to get 2 points.

NM to reshare slides and publish to club.

#### 9. European and Domestic weekend away running (RD)

Corrine Hollanby has shown interest in organising with some great research.

Agreement that RD to liaise with Corrine and form a subgroup to help organise an event

#### 10. Tuesday night Protocol (KH)

Committee member to ensure Welcome new members and check they have found their leader, safety briefing and share any news.

**RD** to send an email to the leaders to get in number order and advise the Committee will give a short announcement before they should leave.

Note should also include the importance to keep to advertised pace.

#### 11. Tuesday night start time (HH)

Suggestion that Gp1 should run without a leader when Donna not there or wait till 7:30 to go with Donna. HH /RD to discuss with Donna.

Noted on previous poll approx. 90% of club wanted 7pm and 8pm groups have not taken off.

JW also raised that Group 12 were not running and there was a gap between 11 and 13 with group 11 running at Gp12 pace. Gp12 to be reinstated and faster runners in Gp11 encouraged to move up.

#### 12. Calendar of events (KH)

Discussion about date clashes. Dates for events at end of minutes to be updated on club calendar and try to give access to committee to update.

Committee agreed that the club would pay for 20 teams at the Beckenham relays.

JW confirmed he has had no interest in the Training fundraising app.

TS commented on the low turnout at the leaders conference and suggested combining it with the leaders social.

HH asked if we needed to continue with 2 Beginner courses a year with nearly 600 members. RD confirmed Apr and Sept to continue this year and drop down to 1 event per year from 2024 in Spring. RD confirmed organising a 1-mile track relay event to be in August for various age categories. RD would look at potential inner club mob match based on alphabet or birthdays.

NM raised that first aid training is a requirement for LIRF renewals.
